

Update in connection with the extreme weather in Norway


The extreme weather is still affecting the accessibility of the infrastructure in Norway and the situation is still critical. The main roads in the south and east of the country are now open and cars are delivered as normal.

The Dovrebanen (Railroad to Trondheim) is still closed due to a bridge that collapsed and fell into the river. It will take a while before this is repaired and the trains to Trondheim can run as normal again.



There has been extreme rainfall in the district around Trondheim over the last 24 hours, which has caused that the E6 and other main roads have been closed. The authorities have issued a warning and asked those living in the area to stay inside. The result of this is that there is verry limited deliveries in the area at the moment.

Torrential rain has been reported in large parts of central Norway for the next 24 hours. This can make the delivery situation even worse, and we are following the situation closely.
